**OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH & WORKER'S COMP - HOLIDAY CLOSURE -**

Occupational Health Services and Worker's Comp Office in Davis will be closed from **December 23, 2021** through **January 2, 2022**.

- Injuries and illnesses should still be reported via the [Injury Report \(EFR\)](#).
- To file a Workers' Compensation claim during this period, call Sedgwick CMS at **877-682-7778**.

For **non-emergency care**, visit **Davis Urgent Care**, located at 4515 Fermi Place, Suite 105, Davis, CA 95618 ([phone/map/directions](#)). Davis Urgent Care is open 365 days a year from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m.**, including holidays.

For **emergency care**, visit the **Sutter Davis Hospital Emergency Room** at 2000 Sutter Place, Davis, CA 95616 ([phone/map/directions](#)).

For **serious injuries**, review [SafetyNet 121](#), and call the following numbers if a report is necessary:

- **Between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on December 27, 28 and 29:** call EH&S at 530-752-1493
- **After 4 p.m. on December 27, 28 and 29:** call Police Dispatch at 530-752-1230
- **December 23, 24, 30 and 31:** call Police Dispatch at 530-752-1230

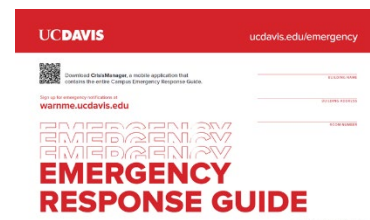
**NEW MEDICAL WASTE CONTAINERS**



- Beginning **January 2022**, Stericycle is making the switch to the square, flat-lid bins for all the accumulation sites in campus.
- Please **do not try to overfill these smaller bins** (weight limit is still 50lbs max & bags cannot be filled over ¾ of the way).
- Make sure to place the bag on correctly until sealed for disposal.
- **Do not use the bin if either of the flaps is missing.**
- The **flaps must close all the way** with nothing sticking out.
